EQUIPMENT INSPECTION FORM

Form to be taken with boat to measurement station ONCE FULLY COMPLETED

The helm is responsible for the measurement form during the measurement procedure

- *The boat must be delivered to the measurement station clean and dry*
- *Hull will be weighed including gennaker sock, bowsprit, rudder stock (including tiller), permanently fixed fittings and control lines including blocks for gennaker pole, downhaul and kicker, foot straps*
- *Hull will be weighed excluding daggerboard, rudder blade, tiller extensions, ratchet blocks (complete) for gennaker sheets, mainsheet, jib sheet and gennaker sheet(s), equipment listed in C.5.1, all other fittings/equipment not permanently fixed to the hull*
- *Mast and hull must be presented to measurement with forestay attached to mast*
- *Foils and sails do not need to be presented at measurement but may be inspected in the boat park during the event*
